ORDER DENYING "MOTION TO DISQUALIFY/RECUSE JUDGE KIMBERLY SHARPE BYRD
FOR CONTINUED DUE PROCESS AND CIVIL RIGHTS VIOLATIONS, IMPROPRIETY, AND
FAILURE TO REPORT SEVERE PROFESSIONAL MISCONDUCT INCLUDING VIOLATIONS
OF AUTOMATIC STAY AND FORUM SHOPPING"

THIS MATTER came before the Court without hearing on Defendant's "Motion To Disqualify/Recuse Judge Kimberly Sharpe Byrd For Continued Due Process And Civil Rights Violations, Impropriety, And Failure To Report Severe Professional Misconduct Including Violations Of Automatic Stay And Forum Shopping". The motion and Exhibits were filed by the pro-se defendant on September 19, 2024. The Court finds and concludes that the motion is in violation of the procedural requirements of Rule 3.330(c)(2) and (g), Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration, and therefore should be denied.
